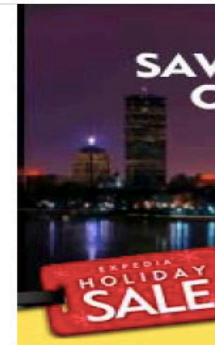

# Manweek 2007 Summary

---

- **Overall, a success**
  - Turnout slightly lower than expected
    - Consistent, from submissions to registrations
  - However, excellent feedback from attendees that did attend
- **Online survey**
  - “How would you rate Manweek on scale 1-5”
    - 100% rate 4 or higher (4 – 83%, 5 – 17%)
  - “If fees remain in the same ballpark, will they make it difficult for you to attend in the future?”
    - 71% no, 29% yes
  - “Would you attend another Manweek in the future?”
    - 86% yes, 14% maybe
- **May consider providing some IEEE support**
  - Would have been nice if IEEE had sent e-mail to local member community

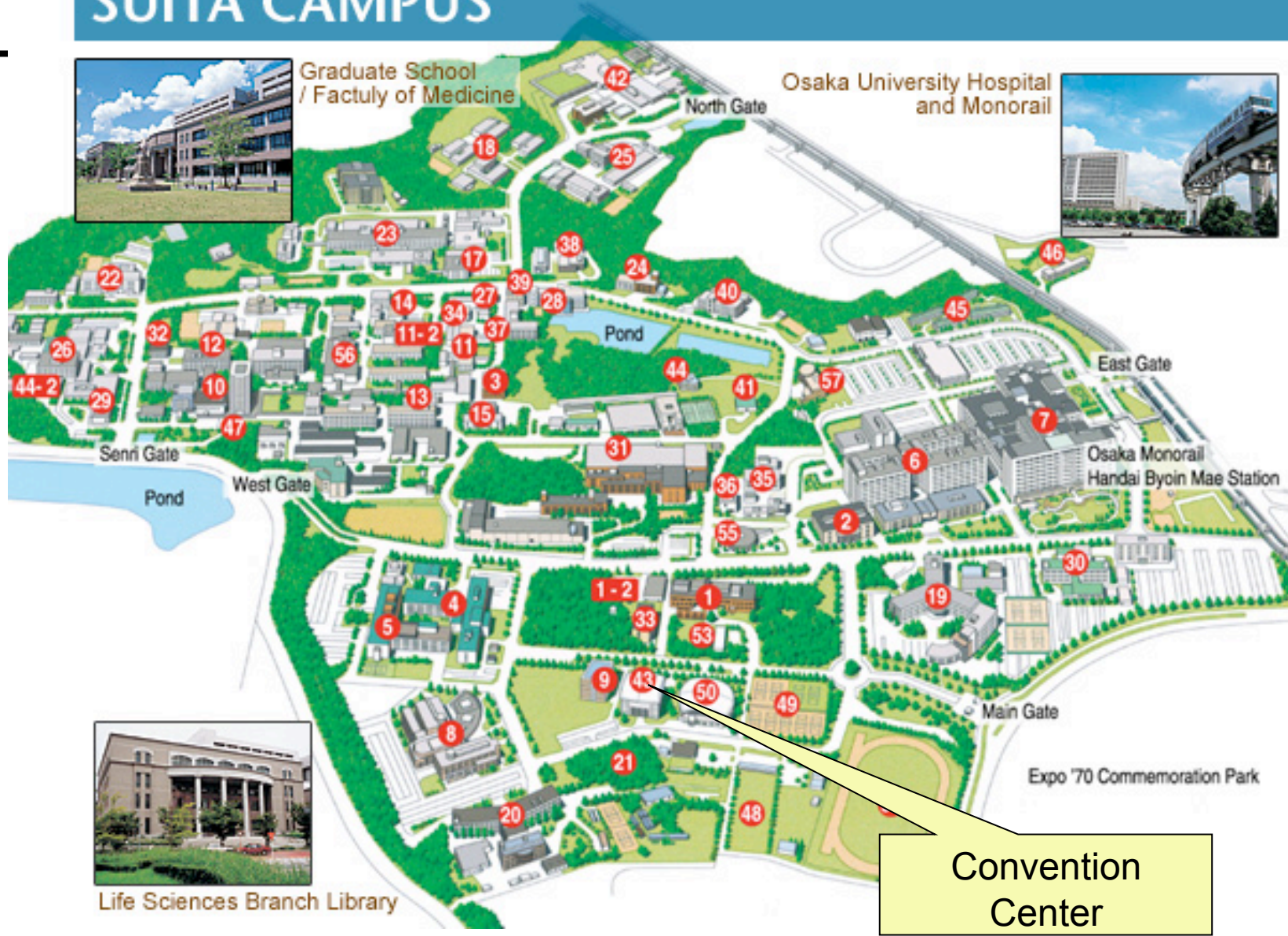

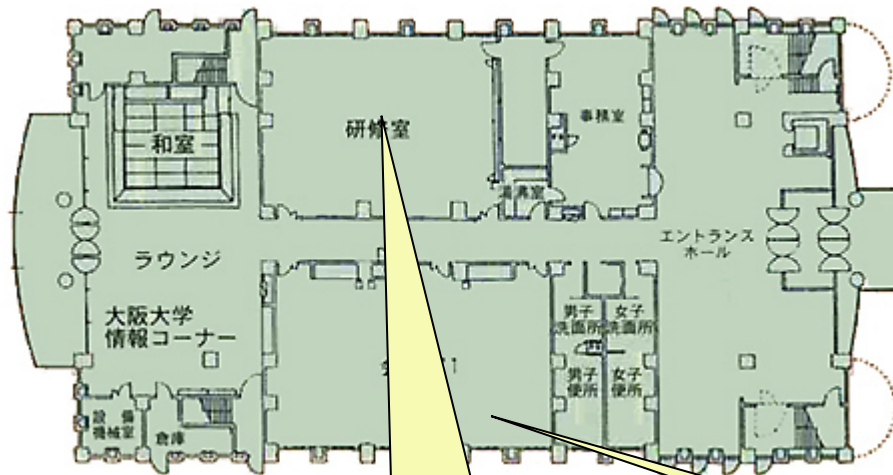

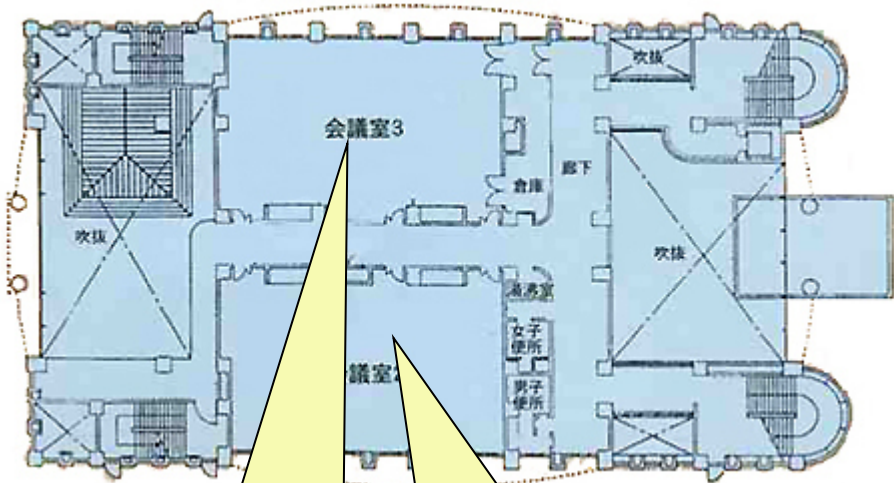

1st Floor



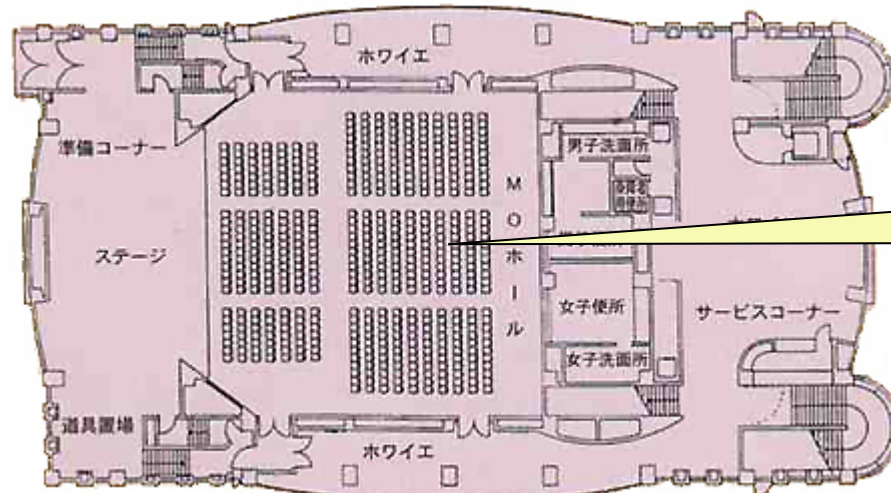
2nd Floor
